AQUATICS DIRECTOR

Job Description: The Aquatics Director oversees all activities and operations of the swimming pool. This role is imperative in ensuring the safety of everyone who uses the pool, and generally in organizing programming that helps swimmers to make the most out of their experience. The Aquatics Director manages a team of 1-2 lifeguards; these staff members work together at the beginning of the summer to create a rotating schedule of shifts that ensures visitors to the pool remain under constant supervision. In addition to open pool hours for recreational swimming, the Pool staff also preside over organized bunk/shop pool parties, pool games, and assist with evening activities such as water aerobics. The Aquatics Director is a crucial bridge of communication-between Shop Heads, Guidance Counselors, Evening Activities Organizers, and the larger Pool staff-for the planning and execution of these activities. Furthermore, this position helps to coordinate and delegate the teaching of swim lessons for interested campers and/or staff.

At least one year in a leadership position with a youth program preferred. Lifeguard certification (American Red Cross or equivalent) required. Must be able to swim confidently, lift up to 50 lbs and navigate rough terrain. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform essential functions of the position.
